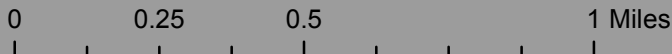

2014 MLRA Invasive Plant Patrol (IPP) volunteer monitoring coverage and identified priority monitoring locations on Goose Pond, Mousam Lake, and Lower Mousam Lake.

Priority areas of the lake include locations with dense aquatic vegetation, known public or private boat access areas, stream and concentrated stormwater input areas, or any combination of all three. The goal of the MLRA IPP team is 100% coverage of the Mousam Lakes Region shoreline.

According to the ME VLMP, Mousam Lake is a waterbody that has been identified as a high risk for the introduction of invasive aquatic species due to heavy recreational use by visiting boaters and proximity to infested waterbodies in ME, NH, and MA.
